ELEMENTS OF A Traditional Kitchen

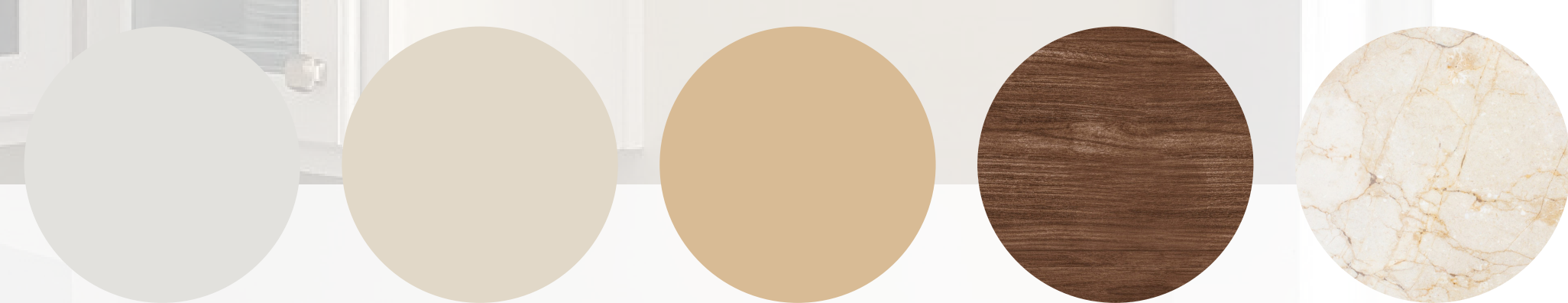
A traditional style kitchen is the perfect backdrop for a household that centers on family, friends, and holidays with a clean, classic look that is comfortable year-round.

Colors & Textures

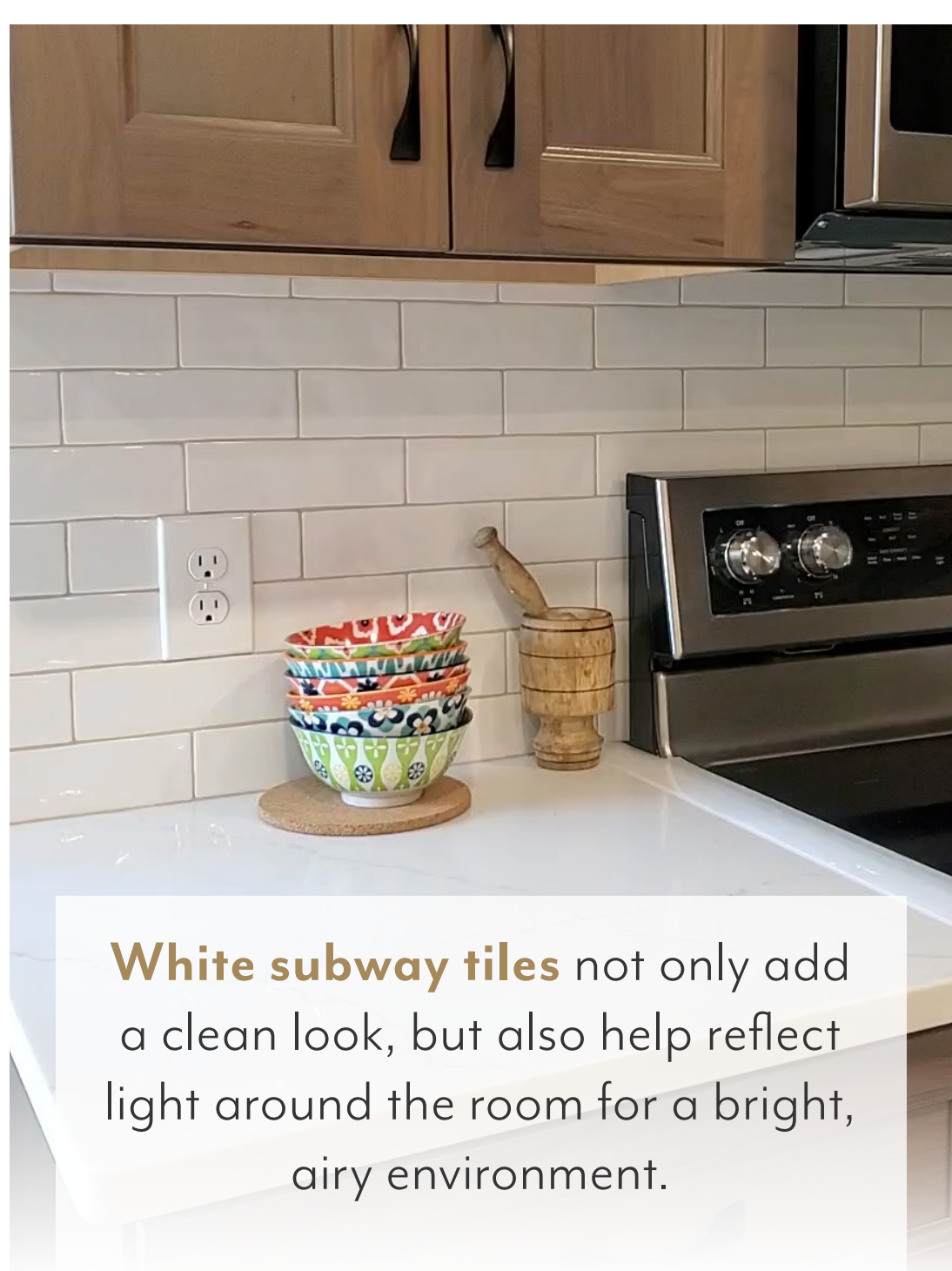


Neutral colors and **nature-inspired textures** are a staple of traditional kitchens.
