Bright, White, & Fresh Accents & Cabinetry

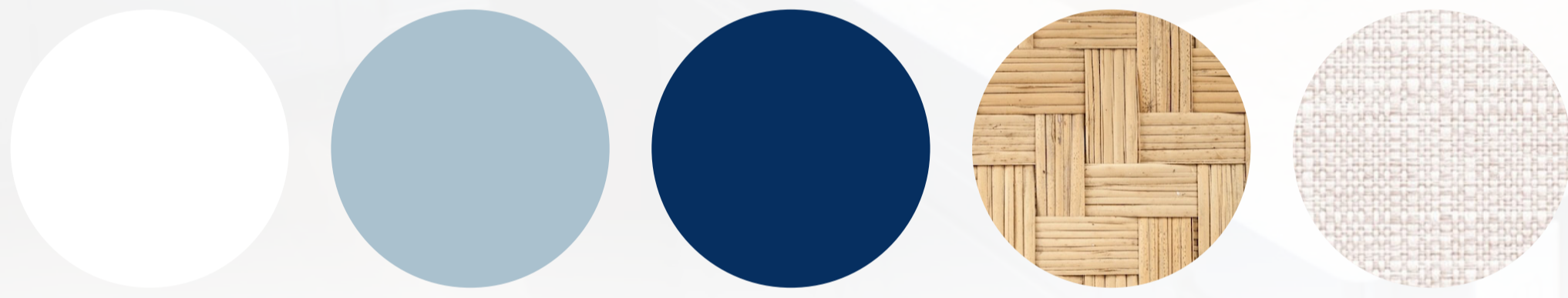


- Fresh, **white walls and cabinetry** keep the kitchen bright and creates the coastal feeling.

Colors & Textures

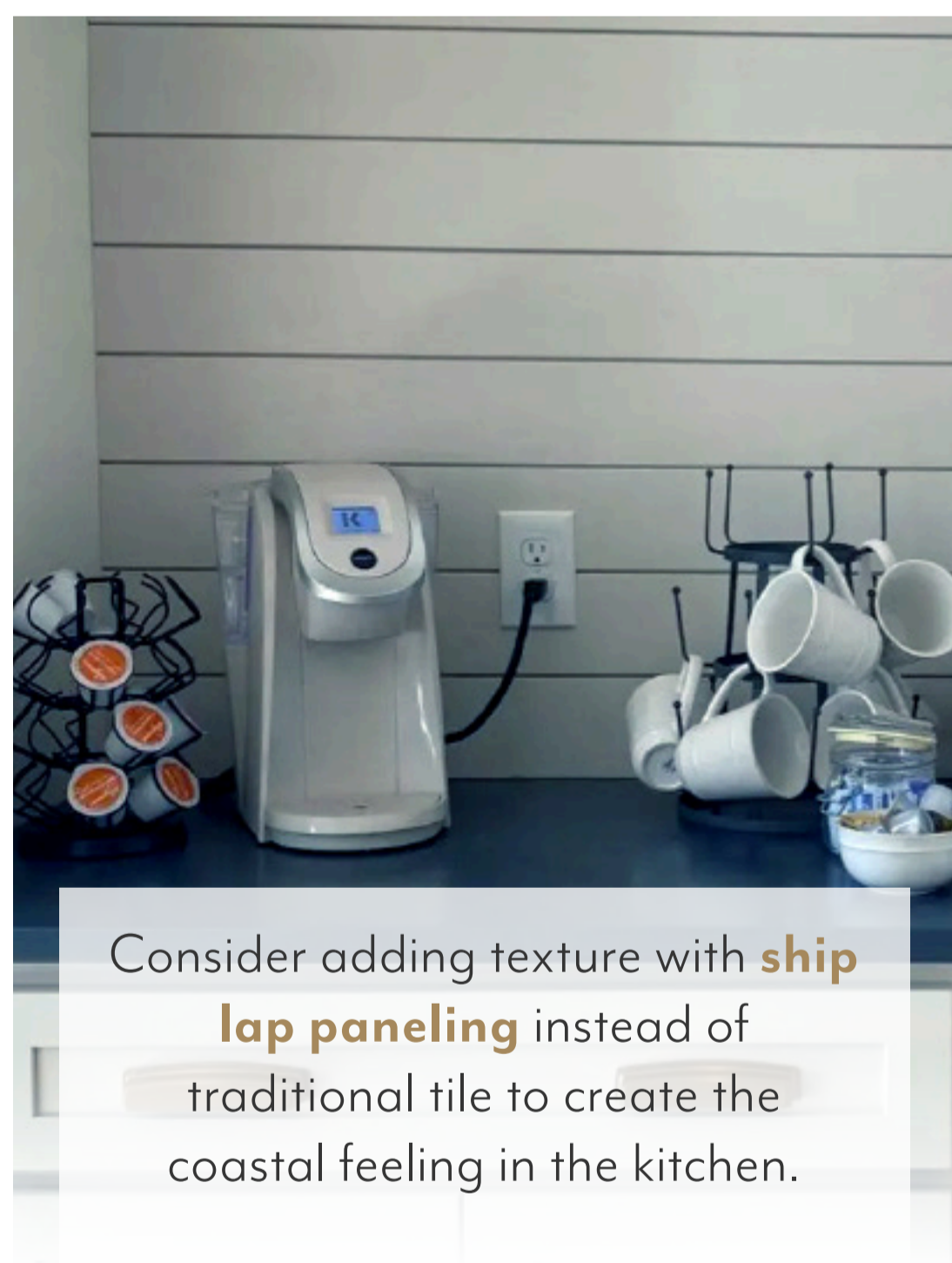


Cool, watery colors such as green and blue are a staple of coastal design.
