Rustic Materials Combined with Modern Updates

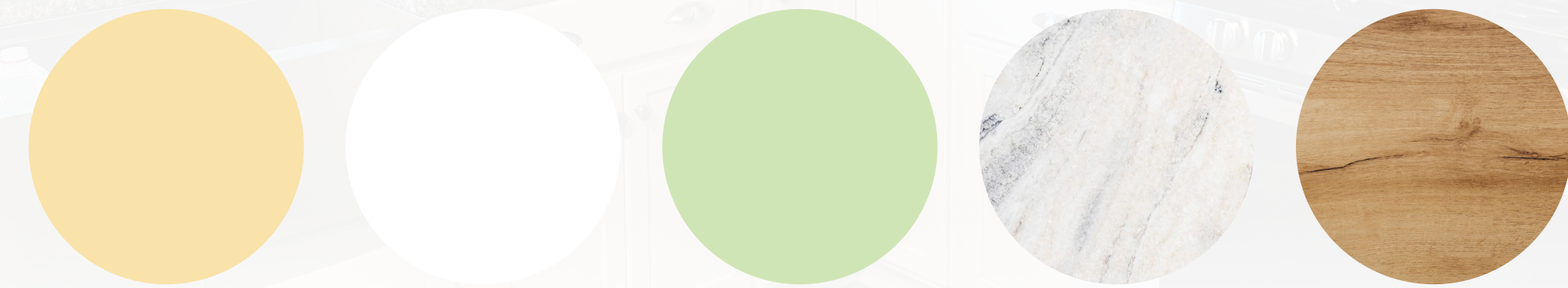
- **Rich stains and natural wood tones** bring in warmth and a countryside feeling.
- Mix and match **aged wood with modern hardware** for an eclectic, lived-in look.
- Opt for hutches and other **furniture-like cabinetry** for storage solutions.



Colors & Textures



Combine **dark aged wood** with **light neutral colors**; mix tones instead of match.

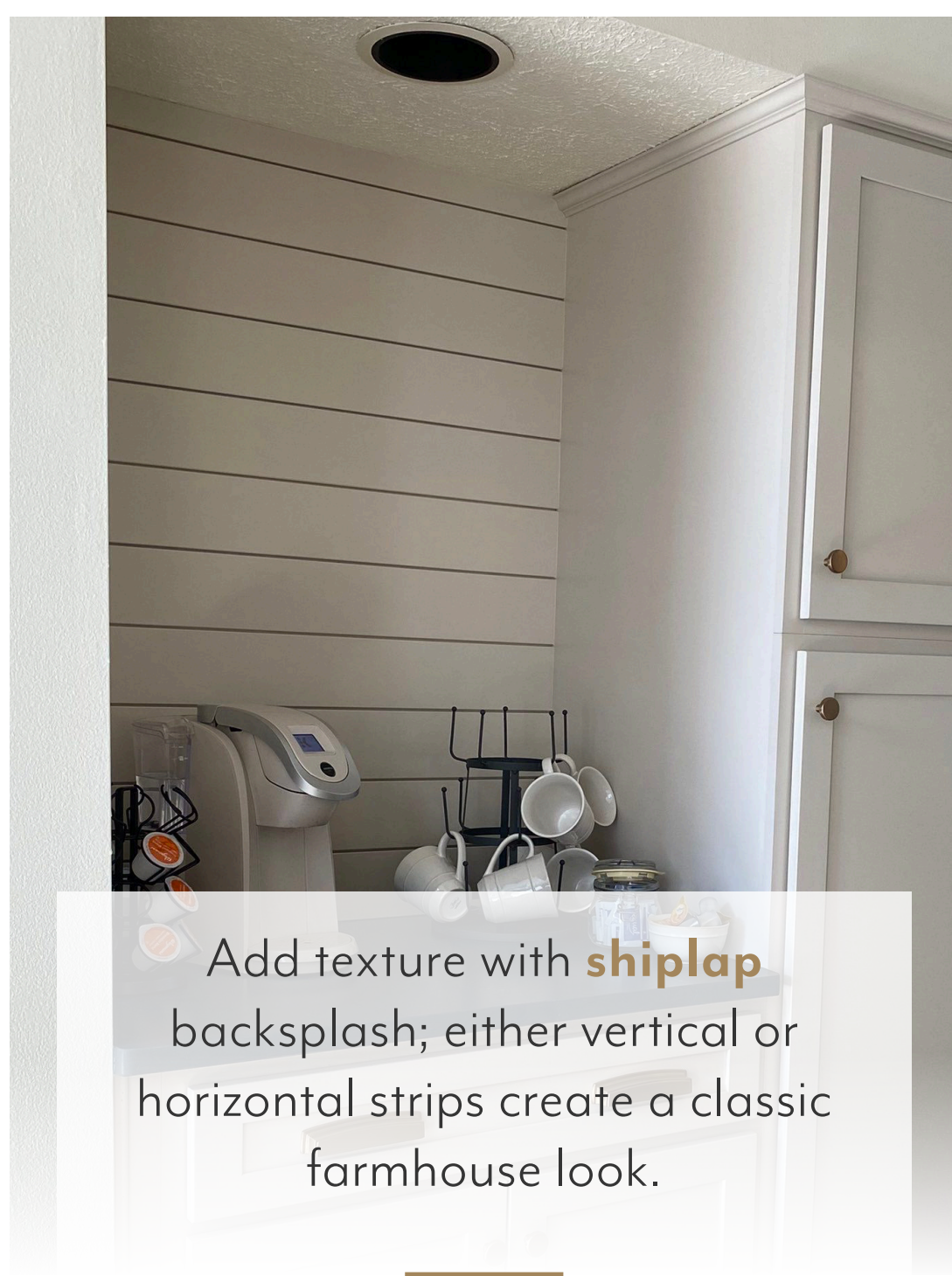


Primary colors such as **blue, red, or yellow** make perfect pops of color.

Tile & Backsplash



Natural stone in place of tile creates a unique and interesting backsplash for a country farmhouse kitchen.



Add texture with **shiplap** backsplash; either vertical or horizontal strips create a classic farmhouse look.
